

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE FOOT PORTION OF ALUM STREET INTO THE CITY OF MORGANTOWN'S STREET SYSTEM FOR PURPOSES OF PUBLIC MAINTENANCE AND CONTROL, IN THE SIXTH WARD OF THE CITY OF MORGANTOWN, MONONGALIA COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA.**

WHEREAS, it appears to the Common Council of the City of Morgantown, West Virginia, and the Council has made a legislative determination that the City should adopt a 125 foot portion of Alum Street, beginning at its intersection with Milton Street as shown on the exhibit hereto attached, and that the 125 foot portion of Alum Street is needed and useful for street purposes, and that it is best interests of the City of Morgantown and the public generally that the 125 foot portion of the street be adopted for public maintenance and control.

WHEREAS, the City of Morgantown hereby ordains for the reasons hereinbefore set forth that a 125 foot portion of Alum Street, beginning at its intersection with Milton Street, as shown on the exhibit hereto attached and made a part of this ordinance is adopted by the City of Morgantown as part of its street system for purposes of public maintenance and control.
